

ARTICLE G.3 FAMILY RESPONSIBILITY LEAVE

The employer will shall grant family responsibility leave as follows pursuant to the *BC Employment Standards Act* Part 6-52:

52–An employee is entitled to up to 5 days of unpaid paid leave during each employment **per** year to meet responsibilities related to:

- (a) the care, health or education of a child in the employee's care, or
- (b) the care or health of any other member of the employee's immediate family as defined in Article G.2

Note: This leave is in addition to the Employment Standard Act Part 6-52. Note: In the event that there are changes to the Employment Standards Act with respect to Family Responsibility Leave, the legislated change provision (A.8) will apply to make the necessary amendments to this provision.

Any and all superior provisions contained in the previous Collective Agreement shall remain part of the Collective Agreement.
