Class Size Update

Reminder: Schools Operating Under the Semester System

This past summer the Class Size Regulation was amended to include a definition of "consult" for the purposes of the class size provisions under the *School Act*. The term "consult" in those sections is now defined in section 1(4) of the Regulation to mean:

- (a) provision by the principal of a school to the teacher of a class with
 - i. information relevant to a proposal for the size and organization of the class, and
 - ii. 2 school days before a decision is made respecting the size and organization of the class for the teacher to consider the proposal and provide the principal with the teacher's views in that regard, and
- (b) consideration by the principal of the teacher's views, if any have been provided, and "consulted" has a similar meaning.

We want to remind districts for those schools operating under a semester system that the requirements of subsections (2.1) to (2.3) of the *School Act* apply throughout the year and to the classes that are starting up in the second semester. The consultation process, and requirements of the *School Act* and Regulations in this regard, should be consistent with that followed in September.
