LOU NO.___ OPT-IN PROCESS

Note:

The purpose of this process is to address the union's desire to maintain existing local language and the employer's desire to standardize language.

The proposal includes 2 packages, cost and non-cost, providing the local union the opportunity to choose between maintaining their existing language or choose to replace existing language with one or both of the proposed provincial packages.

Package 1 is to address non-cost items. Package 2 includes cost items and relates to class size, workload review, non-enrolling ratios, and adjustments to the salary grid.

The local union will determine whether to **maintain existing provisions or** opt into new provincial articles packages.

- 1. When opting for an article into a package, the entire article package shall apply and only that local article shall be replaced replace the corresponding local provisions as listed.
- 2. Once opted into the a provincial article package, the local union may not opt out.
- 3. Where the local union elects not to opt into the provincial article package, the local union shall retain their existing article in its corresponding provisions in their entirety.
- 4. Provisions regarding Term (Article A.1) shall not be subject to this process LOU No.X Opt-in Process applies only to packages that the provincial parties agree to be a part of this process.
- 5. Cross referencing and housekeeping will be addressed through the melding process.
- For the next round, The the local union shall have the opportunity to opt into the provincial article at the end of each round of provincial negotiations package prior to March 1, 2022 to take effect upon ratification of the subsequent agreement.
