Article G.8: Teachers Teaching On Call Conducting Union Business Negotiating Team

Overview

This article establishes an entitlement for Teachers Teaching on Call (TTOCs) who act on a bargaining team to accrue seniority and experience.

Article G.8: Teachers Teaching On Call - Conducting Union Business Negotiating Team

Time spent conducting union business on a local or provincial negotiating team will be recognized for the purpose of seniority and experience recognition.

Explanation

G.8 Time spent conducting union business on a local or provincial negotiating team will be recognized for the purpose of seniority and experience recognition.

Article G.8 establishes that a Teacher Teaching on Call who conducts union business (see Article G.7) in a local or provincial bargaining team will receive seniority and experience recognition for that time. Unlike G.7.4, there is no cap on the number of days which can be accrued each school year.

Implementation

This article was effective upon ratification of the 2013-2019 collective agreement (September 17, 2014).
