

LOU 2: Agreed Understanding of the Term Teacher Teaching on Call

❖ Overview

This letter of understanding establishes the meaning of “Teacher Teaching on Call” (TTOC).

❖ Letter of Understanding No. 2 Re: Agreed Understanding of the Term Teacher Teaching on Call

For the purposes of this collective agreement, the term Teacher Teaching on Call (TTOC) has the same meaning as Teacher on Call/Employee on Call (TOC/EOC) as found in the 2006-2011 Collective Agreement/Working Documents and is not intended to create any enhanced benefits.

The parties will set up a housekeeping committee to identify the terms in the collective agreement/working documents that will be replaced by Teacher Teaching on Call (TTOC).
